

Independent Living Programs

The Independent Living Programs provide outreach services as well as some residential programs for youth ages 12 - 21, who are in or transitioning out of foster care, to prepare them for inter-dependent living.

Target Population

- Outreach services for any youth in or transitioning out of foster care
- Youth most needy of services
- Preference given to youth in permanent foster care
- ILP Foster Home: 12 - 17 year old youth
- ILPTA: current and former foster youth or young men transitioning out of Hawaii Youth Correctional Facility
- Haloa House: current or former female foster youth and Family Court referrals

Residential Admission Criteria

Able to function in community with minimal supervision. Capable of employment. Willing and able to participate in all program activities. No drug/alcohol use, violent behavior, criminal activity within past 6 months, not in psychiatric crisis.

Discharge Criteria

- Completion of Goals/Program
- Lack of Participation
- Youth Terminates Services
- Youth Ages Out of Program
- Major Rule Violations in Residential Setting

Youth Responsibilities

Independent Living Program (ILP) and ILP Foster Home

Attend high school; input into service plan, participate in program and make progress toward skills attainment and personal goals.

Independent Living Training Apartments (ILPTA) & Haloa House

Identify higher education and/or vocational goals; obtain and attend work (hours pro-rated if in school); input into service plan; develop personal goal plan; participate in program and make progress toward skills and personal goals attainment; pay monthly program fees (refundable on completion of program in good standing); purchase own groceries and cook own meals (subsidy available).

Hapai Home

Learn parenting skills & community resources; attend high school; input into service plan; participate in nurturing curriculum group; participate in program and make progress toward skills attainment and personal goals.

Fee Structure

- ILP - no charge
- ILPTA & Haloa - residents pay for some living costs
