Foster Youth Rights You have a right to a safe home, free from physical, emotional or sexual abuse. You have a right to adequate food, shelter and clothing. You have a right to receive an education and attend school, even if you move to a new district. You have a right to medical, dental and mental health services. You have a right to regular visitation with your family, including parents and siblings. You have a right to attend your court hearings and/or to speak with the Judge about your case. You have a right to contact your Guardian ad Litem (GAL) and Social Worker. You have a right to receive Independent Living Program information and participate in the program. You have a right to ask for your own attorney. You have a right to be involved in developing your case's permanent plan (if age 14 or older) and in planning for your future. You have a right to access certain personal records like your birth certificate and Social Security card.
