Supervisor Contract Rules/Expectations

I understand that _____, is on supervision for a sexual offense or sexually-related behavior. I understand that someone who has committed a sexual offense maybe reluctant to tell others about his behavior and their interest in deviant behavior. The purpose of my entering this contract is to assist in providing adequate supervision of the offender to prevent further sexual offending behavior and/or assist the offender in avoiding behavior which violates offender rules of supervision, specifically the condition that he/she has not unsupervised contact with any person(s) under the age of 18.

The term “supervisor” refers to an individual who knows the offender’s complete history of deviant behavior. Either Probation or treatment has verified the supervisor’s awareness. The supervision relationship is a privilege enjoyed by the offender and in no way relieves the offender of direct responsibility for his own conduct. Supervisors are considered “responsible adults” who may supervise an offender’s contact with specified minors. All such contact, however, must be consistent with the offender’s legal requirements and limitations and must be approved in advance by the offender’s case management team (Probation and treatment).

Probation is to verify that both parents/guardians are fully advised of the defendant’s conviction prior to any consideration in order to make informed decision about the safety and welfare of their children.

The following includes a list of responsibilities and expectations for offenders and supervisors during approved supervised contact with minor. These responsibilities and expectations are intended to promote the safety and welfare of the minor(s).

Rules: (both offender and supervisor shall initial each rule indicating understanding of the rule)

- ____/____ The offender may **NEVER** be alone with any minor.
- ____/____ The offender shall not whisper or keep secrets with any minor.
- ____/____ No gifts without prior approval from the case management team.
- ____/____ The approved supervisor is to be within view of the offender when minors are present at all times.
- ____/____ No horseplay, tickling, wrestling or pinching with any minor.
- ____/____ The offender will not be responsible for any disciplinary actions involving a minor.
- ____/____ Never discuss issues of sexuality with minor(s).
- ____/____ Only the supervisor may assist the minor(s) with personal hygiene, bathroom and self-care activities.
- ____/____ The offender nor the supervisor is permitted to consume or be under the influence of alcohol or any illicit substances during the supervised visitation.
- ____/____ The offender nor the supervisor is permitted to utilize any type of computer equipment during supervised visitation.
- ____/____ The offender will not initiate or maintain contact with minors. Further clarification will be provided the containment team, ie. kissing, hugging, tickling, wrestling, etc.
- ____/____ For each and every approved supervised visitation, each minor that will be present needs to be identified by name, age and relationship to the offender. No other minor(s) will be permitted that are not identified per this contract.
- ____/____ Only the approved supervisor may supervise contact with minor(s).

- _____/ ____ The offender shall be responsible for his/her appearance at all time. This includes the wearing of undergarments and clothing in places where another person may be expected to view you.
- _____/ ____ There will be no overnight visitation unless approved in advance by the containment team.
- _____/ ____ Any future supervised contact will be approved in advance by Probation and treatment.
- _____/ ____ It is the supervisor's role to observe, provide feedback, and ensure the children are safe from all physical, verbal, and/or sexual abuse. It is NOT their role to baby-sit or provide therapy.
- _____/ ____ Offender will not enter closed doors without knocking and gaining permission before opening the door and the offender will always use locked doors to use the bathroom or in a state of undress.
- _____/ ____ If there are any violations of this contract OR any concerns about the visit observed, the offender and supervisor are responsible to tell the case management team within 24 hours of the violation. The case management team will discuss the issue and potentially revise this contract or suspend this contract.
- _____/ ____ If the supervisor is concerned that any of the children are at risk emotionally or physically, she/he will intervene and communicate her/his feelings to the client. If contact must be terminated for safety reasons, the offender agrees that he will be the one to leave the residence and find alternative accommodations
- _____/ ____ Full active releases of information for all supervisors, probation/parole, and all therapists involved with the family must be maintained.
- _____/ ____ Offender will not engage in sexual talk with, or sexual education of, any minors. If the child initiates some conversation regarding sexual issues, the offender must immediately bring the supervisor into the conversation and allow them to answer the questions or take the lead in the discussion. In addition, they must contact the case management team immediately to discuss this issue and how it was resolved.
