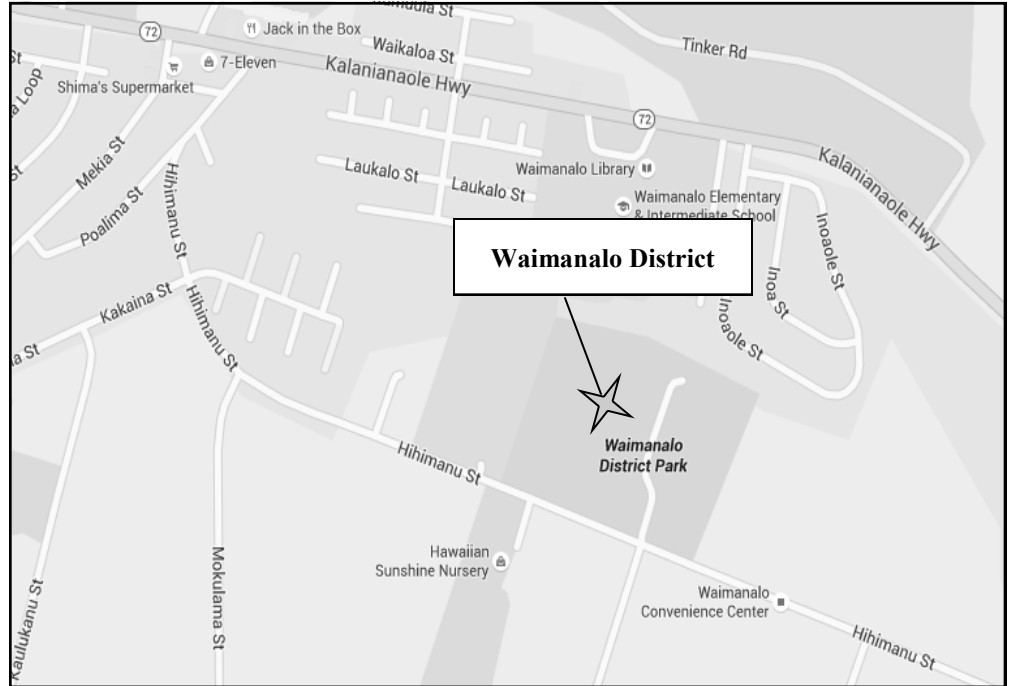
- FREE training and childcare open to all **resource, adoptive, guardianship, permanency, and kinship** families.

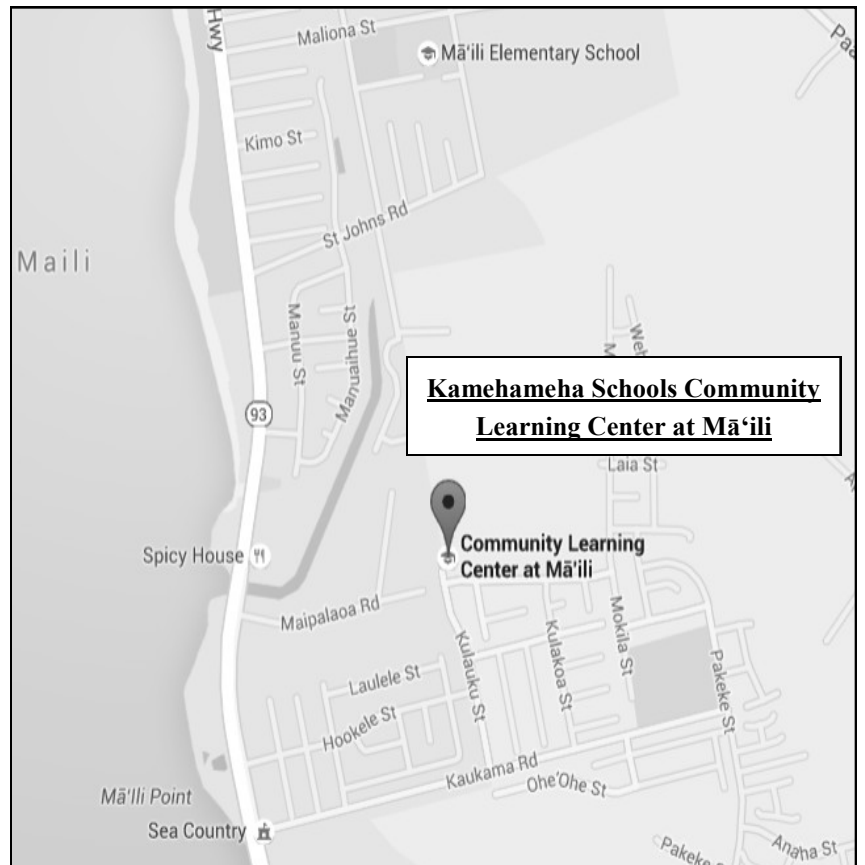
