**An exciting new opportunity in Hawai'i helps young adults who exit foster care at 18 to build successful futures.**

### ▶▶▶ What is Imua Kākou?

Imua Kākou, “*moving forward together*”, is a voluntary program which provides support to former foster youth between 18-21 years old.

### ▶▶▶ Who is ELIGIBLE for Imua Kākou?

- Young adults between 18-21st birthday
- Young adults who exited foster care in Hawai'i at 18 or older, OR
- Young adults placed in legal guardianship or adopted from foster care at age 16 or older in Hawai'i (*may be eligible for financial support only*)

### ▶▶▶ What are the BENEFITS of Imua Kākou?

- Medical and dental coverage
- Living assistance payments
- Monthly one-on-one support to connect with resources and help to plan for and achieve personal goals

### ▶▶▶ How do participants QUALIFY for Imua Kākou? *They must meet at least ONE of the following criteria:*

- Working on a GED/diploma
- Enrolled in college/vocational program
- Participating in an employment program or efforts to remove barriers to employment
- Working at least part-time (80 hrs/month)
- Medically disabled
