



### **Definition**

 Sex Trafficking: the recruitment, harboring, transportation, or obtaining of a person for the purpose of a commercial sex act, in which the commercial sex act is induced by force, fraud, or coercion or in which the person induced to perform such act has not attained 18 years of age







# **Who is Being Targeted**



- Average age of victim is 12–14 years old
- Girls searching for "love" or "acceptance"
- Runaways
- Girls with history of physical, emotional, sexual abuse in the home
- Any girl from any background can be targeted

# **Psychology of Modern Day Slavery**

- PIMP: Prostitutes Innocent Minors for Profit
- PIMPs offer victims something they need, something they want, something good....
- PIMPs make promises for a better life, a new family, a boyfriend, someone who really understands them like no one ever has before.....the reality is something very different













# **PIMP Recruiting Tactics**

- "Love"- starting a relationship with girl-promising whatever she's lacking (PSYCHOLOGICAL PLAY) (FRAUD)
- Getting girls hooked on drugs (COERCION)
- Kidnapping (FORCE)
- Inviting girls to be on music videos/ or to model (FRAUD)
- Threatening (COERCION)
- Through other girls that work for them (COERCION/FRAUD)
- Helping someone out then making them feel like they owe something (FRAUD)
- Being sold online by family members (FORCE)



# **Sex Trafficking in Hawaii**

- Prostituted women and children walk the street in Waikiki daily
- Brothels island wide disguised as: massage parlors, hostess clubs, strip clubs
- Areas with large male populations like Waikiki strip,
   Chinatown, Leeward Oahu and near military bases are hot spots
- Online chat sites and classified services make it easy to target and traffic very young children unnoticed
- Large sporting events (golf, football), business conferences, military exercises, and sex tourism make Hawaii a hot spot for sex trafficking

# Why Girls Just Don't Leave

#### The PIMP:

- Manipulates
- Preys on child's need for love and affection
- Provides security, basic needs, and lodging
- Brainwashing
- Threatens and invokes fear

#### The Victim

- Feels shame
- Distrusts law enforcement
- Lacks resources or a home to return to
- · Fears for her family
- Believes she has lost her value and worth



# **Long Term Effects of Abuse**

- Sexually Transmitted Diseases
- · Police record
- Delay of education
- Post Traumatic Stress
   Disorder
- Depression
- Fear
- Anxiety
- Suicide



- Drug abuse/overdose
- Self mutilation
- Eating disorders





# **Dangers of Social Media**

- People often let their guard down when they are not faceto-face with another person (Facebook, Twitter, SnapChat, Instagram)
  - Detailed postings of personal information makes it easy for predators to profile and stalk their victims
  - Once a picture is posted; it is near impossible to remove
  - A false sense of security is dangerous
- Online social media has become an effective recruiting tool for PIMPs and sexual predators
  - The rate of grooming online is growing rapidly
- As social media increases, sexual assaults continue to increase



# **Pornography**

- Pornography fuels sex trafficking; internet is its platform
- 1 of 5 pornographic images is of a child; 55% of child pornography is created in the U.S
- Pornography harms:
  - Negatively impacts emotional and mental health
  - Struggle to distinguish between porn fantasy and authentic intimate relationships
  - Highly addictive, looking leads to touching
  - Rewires the brain and drastically influences how dopamine and other chemicals are received and used in the brain

# Society Glamorizes the Sex Industry

- Popular culture glamorizes the relationship between PIMPs and their victims (music, movies, video games, sub-culture terminology adapted and used in everyday life)
- Young women are bombarded with the message that sexual appeal to men is what gives them value
- Desensitizes people to the violent reality and dehumanization that is always present within sex trafficking
- Encourages violence and disrespect towards women and girls
