WHY ARE WE DOING CRT?



RESPOND WITHIN 2 HOURS OF REPORT OF MALTREATMENT FROM HOSPITALS, POLICE PROTECTIVE CUSTODY AND SCHOOLS



INCREASE RELATIVE PLACEMENT WHEN CHILDREN MUST BE REMOVED

KEEP CHILDREN SAFELY AT HOME



PREVENT UNNECESSARY REMOVALS IN A CRISIS

HOW DOES IT HELP FAMILIES?

- FAMILIES HAVE ACCESS TO SOCIAL WORKERS IN TIME OF CRISIS
- CHILDREN ARE SUPPORTED IN THEIR OWN COMMUNITIES
- FAMILIES HAVE ENHANCED CAPACITY AND SUPPORT TO SAFELY CARE FOR THEIR CHILDREN



HOW DOES IT HELP ME?



- WORKLOADS ARE REDUCED DUE TO REDUCTION IN PLACEMENT
- SOCIAL WORKERS CAN MAKE APPROPRIATE REFERRALS FOR FAMILIES IN CRISIS.

WHAT ARE WE LEARNING?

WE WANT TO PREVENT CHILDREN COMING INTO CARE FOR LESS THAN 30 DAYS (CALLED "SHORT-STAYERS").

- ON OAHU, IN 2015, **56%** OF CASES REFERRED TO CRT KEPT CHILDREN SAFELY AT HOME, THUS PREVENTING UNNECESSARY PLACEMENT IN A CRISIS.
- ONLY **22%** OF CHILDREN SERVED BY CRT ON OAHU WERE SHORT-STAYERS.
