Our Assessment Center is open to youth who are victims/survivors of commercial sexual exploitation and sex trafficking.

We accept Self Referrals as well as referrals from Child Protective Services, Family Court, Parents, Police and Youth Agencies. It is a voluntary program.

Self and parent referred residents will be expected to participate in family support services targeted towards reunification or other alternative arrangements. Youth and families are provided referrals to needed community services.

Hale Kipa is a private, non-profit, statewide, culturally responsive organization dedicated to help at-risk youth and their families. Services range from outreach to prevention to treatment. Persons with urgent needs or in emergency situations are given priority. All persons are treated equitably and without favoritism, subject to limitations imposed by contractual obligations.

Services are Flexible, Free, Creative and determined by the Youth's and Family's Needs.

Criteria for Admission

- ◆ Youth is suspected/confirmed of being sexually exploited/trafficked
- ◆ Youth is 12-17 years old
- ◆ Physical and TB clearance
- ◆ Youth (and family) willing to comply with program expectations

Youth Responsibilities

- ◆ Respect people and property
- ◆ Participate in program activities
- ◆ Follow program rules
- ◆ Participate in support services
- ◆ Attend an educational program

Services

- ◆ 24 hour nurturing, safe emergency shelter
- ◆ Basic needs
- ◆ Strength-based individual, group, and family support/stabilization services
- ◆ Educational support/services/classes
- ◆ Coordinating services with and meeting place for youth service providers
